## INTRODUCTION

God designed the church and our families to help us grow in Christlikeness. Today we will discover how we might together cultivate a love for God in our own hearts and model the importance of loving God and His church.

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## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### 1. READ DEUTERONOMY 6:4-9.

- a. Since God is one (v. 4), what did Moses tell them to do (v. 5)?
- b. How were they to love God (v. 5)? Was there any part of themselves that they didn't have to use when loving God? What does it look like for us to love God with the different dimensions of our being (heart, soul, and strength)?
- c. What does it mean to have the Word of God "in your heart"? How does memorizing Scripture help us love God more deeply? What effect does it have on our families?
- d. What do you think it means to "impress" God's commandments on your children (verse 7)? Looking at verse 7, when might be appropriate times to "talk about them" in your context?
- e. In addition to studying the Bible together, why is it important for families to take time to pray together?

### 2. READ HEBREWS 10:19-25.

- a. The writer of Hebrews gives three commands that arise out of knowing that Jesus is our Great High Priest (vv. 22-24). What are they? How does knowing that Jesus is our Great High Priest make us able to obey these commands?
- b. What are some practical ways we as a family might "be concerned for one another in order to promote love and good works"?
- c. How might seeking the Lord together as a family help family members see the areas of their lives that need to grow or change?

d. How can we promote love and good works in our church? How does our concern for each other demonstrate the gospel?

e. Why did the writer of Hebrews remind his readers that “the Day” is “drawing near” (v. 25)? Why might we need that reminder as we seek to build up the body of Christ at our church?
